Sandy Hart, representing the Ky Veteran and Patriot Museum spoke about the 20th anniversary of the WWII DC trip on May 4th, 2024, and the celebration that is being planned.

Motion by Nathan Whipple second by Stonnie Dennis with the vote of 4 ayes and 1 nay, motion passed to approve Resolution 2021-ARPA #4.1. This gives \$49,000 to build outdoor restrooms and fill the swimming pool in to the Ballard County Country Club. Motion by Jody Brown second by Chip Bisson, unanimous vote to rescind ARPA #4.

There was a discussion about Resolution # 2022-09-20-001(A). This resolution involves \$65,000 revenue sharing from the Fiscal Court PILT with Brightnight commercial solar project potentially locating in Ballard County, with Ballard County Schools, no action was taken.

The 80/20 FYE KYTC Resolution for \$80,000 was presented. The bridges and culverts the funding will be used to repair these structures on roads listed as follows: Robey, Albert Hook, Mt. Pleasant, Williams Lane, Smokey and Hodge Road. *Motion by Ryan Hedrick second by Nathan Whipple, unanimous on vote to approve the resolution.*

The Fiscal Court is applying for a DRA grant for Ceredo Road.
